The 210 repeater needs an RF band sweep, Mark WA0TOP will help run a sweep.

Herb KE0PXJ will check with Lions Club about use of pavilion 15 for Field Day.

Dave KF0XQ presented information on Coaxial Cable and Effective Radiated Power.
